Available are 16 conference scholarships for undergraduate physics students who may be interested in a future career in Medical Physics. These scholarships will be allocated evenly amongst Australian Universities providing a degree in physics.

Since this conference will be held in Canberra, there will be 4 scholarships available to students from ANU. The scholarship covers the conference registration fee and associated social functions.

Sponsored students will be exposed to a variety of radiotherapy streams at the conference, participate in the ACPSEM's Training Education and Accreditation Program (TEAP) session, meet with representatives of the ACPSEM and visit local radiation oncology facilities to gain a grasp of work in the field.
